Olympic Games, World Championship, European Championship, Canada Cup and World Cup of Hockey games are recognized as official games. Team Sweden has played official games since 1920

All Olympic Games tournaments during 1920-1968 is also recognized as World Championship tournaments.

The official games from Olympic Games 1920 was later (1982) by the International Ice Hockey Federation also recognized as World Championship games

For European nations Olympic Games during 1936-1968 is also recognized as European Championship tournaments.

For European nations during 1933-1991 World Championship tournaments is also recognized as European Championship tournaments.

Separate European Championship tournaments was played during 1910-1932.

Since 1992 there are no European Championship tournaments played.
